SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Block 14 (Description of Amendment/Modification): The purpose of this amendment is to respond to the following vendor's pre-quotation questions to the solicitation referenced at block 9A and B.

Respond to the vendor's pre-quotation question:

Q01: [Furniture] Does this space have an elevator, or will this require stair carry?

A01: No elevator. Stair Carry

Q02: [Furniture] Are we required to remove and dispose of the existing furniture? Or is the government? 3.3.3 is confusing.

A02: Remove, place on pallet, & make sure all screws/bolts are with it. To be able to be assembled again at another time.

Q03: [Furniture] Printer Wagon - is this a cabinet a printer sits on with paper storage underneath?

A03: Yes.

Q04: [Furniture] Cafe Counter. I only see 1 counter on your floor plan circled below in Red. Is the 2nd counter above that "grayed" out?

A04: No, it's one counter with a shelf below the counter. See revised Layout Plan.

Q05: [Flooring] Are we required to remove and dispose of the floor tile? Or is the government? 3.3.3 is confusing.

A05: Yes, remove and dispose of.

Q06: [Flooring] Is the floor tile vinyl, rubber, carpet or some other surface? Can you provide pictures?

A06: Vinyl. No pictures. They can see it when they do the site visit.

Q07: [Flooring] When replacing the floor tile, is wall base, and transition strips needed?

A07: Yes.

Q08: Does the job include electrical outlet wiring?

A08: No.

Q09: We are considering arriving by vehicle; however, if arriving by car is not recommended or not permitted for the site visit, please kindly let us know, and we will follow your guidance accordingly.

A09: If they don't already have access then car is not recommended. The process takes months to process.

Q10: On page 3, paragraph 1.2, the location of work is specified as SRF Sasebo. However, on page 9 of the same specification, the inspection and acceptance location is listed as Yokosuka Base. Could you please clarify this point? Should the order be shipped to Yokosuka Base first for inspection and acceptance, and then transported to and installed in Sasebo?

A10: Inspection/acceptance location is Sasebo. Read location stated at page 9 "Inspection and Acceptance Location" and page 10 "Address and POC" as Sasebo, not Yokosuka. This is system issue and cannot fix as of now.

Q11: Are Japanese-made supplies acceptable, provided they meet the measurements in the specifications, or must they be exclusively purchased in the United States?

A11: Yes, Japanese supplies are acceptable.
