

## SUMMARY OF CHANGES

**Block 14 (Description of Amendment/Modification):** The purpose of this amendment is to answer to questions raised by vendors and indicate the delivery point by map as attachment.

Q1. SOW 6. Place of Performance - At contractor's facility. This means that the customer comes to KTR's facility or shop in order to check the performance of new machine before the KTR delivers to SRF?

A1. The Government doesn't need to go to the facility to check the performance before delivery. The main thing that the vendor needs to install the equipment and conduct an operational test to verify that the equipment is functioning properly.

Q2. SOW 2. Warranty: Manufacture Warranty. The Manufacture Warranty is 24 months. The customer accepts 24 months or 24 months is not enough?

A2. If the warranty is for 24 months, the Government may accept that.

Q3. The customer needs the training by OEM engineer?

A3. Yes, the Government may have training for the workers so that they will have a better understanding of how this new equipment works.

Q4. When delivering the equipment, we plan to unload it using the truck's power gate and move it to the delivery location using the wheels that come with the equipment. Would this method be acceptable?

A4. The method is acceptable.

Q5. Would it be possible to provide a forklift if necessary?

A5. The Government will be able to provide forklift if necessary.

Q6. Regarding the laptop, if there aren't 3 USB Type-A ports, would it be acceptable to use an external USB hub?

A6. Yes, it is acceptable to use an external USB hub.
