

STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW), ICN 970063NLS1

1. SCOPE:

- 1.1 The purpose of this procurement is for the contractor to Provide and Operate 50-meter class Man-Lift for inspection, lubrication, painting work for SP1 Portal Crane. Provide all required labor, tools, materials, and equipment to accomplish these requirements. (Operator is not required only when providing JLG.)
